**Teams:** All NWOAL member schools

**Times:** We will be having a coaches meeting for information and scratches at 9:15am at the finish line.

**Busses:** Park behind the Delta Middle School building.

**Parking:** Spectator parking will utilize the Delta Elementary and Middle School parking lots.

**Camp Sites:** Camp sites will be at the north end of the track outside the fence. Please stay off of the infield and away from the field event areas! Please pick up trash at your camp site when the meet has concluded.

**Shot/Discus:** The shot and discus areas are located outside the facility. Please have your athletes go in and out the gate near the event area.

**Running Event Entrance and Exit:** All runners will check in with the clerk at the northwest end of the track. The gate will be open at the Bull Pen area. Once your race is completed all runners must exit the gate at the finish line. Runners will not be permitted to hang out in the infield. (Coaches, please help us keep your athletes off the infield).

**Admission:** \$5 per car. No passes will be accepted.

**To Finals:** Running events – top 8 times to finals  
Shot put/discus/long jump – top 9 distances to finals

**Awards:** Medals will be given to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places and ribbons for 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>. The traveling plaques will be presented to the overall girls' and boys' league champion at the completion of the meet. Final results will be posted online.

**Scoring:** Scoring will be on a 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 basis.  
Relay Events – Score 7 places: 10-8-6-4-3-2-1

**Timing:** Tiger Timing

**Restrooms:** Restrooms are located at the green barn.

**Starting Blocks:** Will be provided, however, you are more than welcome to bring yours.

**Concessions:** The concession stand will be open for the event.

**Spikes/Markings:** 1/4" spikes must be used on all track and runway surfaces. They will be checked carefully at the entrance and before events. Tennis balls should be used to mark runways and relay marks. NO TAPE please.
