Entries: Entries will be done online at www.baumspage.com. The window is already open, and it will close **at 10:00 AM on Tuesday, May 10**. There will be no scratch window. Enter no more than 2 individuals per event. Please remember to enter the **most consistent times**, not the very best one! That way we will get more reasonable and fair seedings. We will accept changes up to the begin-ning of the meet on Thursday, but if possible email them to the address above. Lane assignments, starting heights, etc., will be posted on baumspage and emailed to each head coach sometime Tuesday afternoon or evening.

Workers: Each school will supply one person to act as a backup timer, plus a worker to help with a field event. Field event assignments are on the schedule page. **Please email these workers to Tim Murray at tmurray@gibsonburgschools.org.**

Timing: We will be using our FinishLynx fully automatic timing system. All your times will be measured to the hundredth of a second.

Facilities: We have an 8-lane all-weather track. Please use 1/8 or 1/4 inch spikes. Tape is acceptable for mark-ing the jumps, and tennis balls or the like should be used for relays. Please use your own batons.

Implements: Please weigh in your implements in the garage by the pole vault pit upon arrival.

Sprints: In the short sprints, the heats will be seeded as evenly as possible based on submitted times, while keeping athletes from the same school in different heats. If three prelim heats are required, the top two from each heat plus the next two fastest times will advance. If only two heats are required, then the top two places from each heat plus the next four fastest times will advance. In the 200 M Hurdles and 400 M Dash, athletes will be placed into two or three heats, run from slower to faster, based on submitted times. However, anyone can score from either heat.

Stuff: We will have our concession stand open, with t-shirts available. Admission is \$4.00 adults, \$3.00 students, and \$2.00 for senior citizens.

Schedule: Please review the attached time schedule for other details.

Awards: There will be a team trophy for champion. Individually, we will score 6 places, with the top 3 re-ceiving All-Conference ribbons. Awards will be available in the press box after the meet.

Coaches: There will be a short coaches' meeting at 4:00 in the garage near the pole vault pit. There will also be a hospitality room with snacks and drinks for all the coaches in the garage as well.
