- Teams:** Kateri Academy, Emmanuel Christian, MVCD, Northwood, Ottawa Hills, and Toledo Christian
- Entries:** Entries will be done online at www.baumspage.com. The window will close **at 11:00 AM on Tuesday, May 7**. There will be no scratch window. Enter no more than 2 individuals per event, and enter the **most consistent times**, not the very best one! Be aware that **once the deadline passes, there can be no additions**, only scratches or drop/adds.
- Scratches:** We will accept scratches or drop/adds up to the beginning of the meet on Thursday, but if possible email them to the address above. Once the meet begins, we will accept drops, of course. However, no drop/adds will be allowed, except in case of injury. If an athlete drops because of injury, he is then ineligible for any following events. Any changes during the meet must be made at the press box, not at the event or at check-in. The clerk will NOT accept changes.
- Workers:** Each school will supply one person to act as a backup timer, plus a worker to help with a field event. Field event assignments are on the schedule page. **Please email these workers to Ken James at his email address below.**
- Facilities:** We have an 8-lane all-weather track, with all-weather surfaces on the jumping surfaces as well. Please use $\frac{1}{8}$ or $\frac{1}{4}$ inch spikes. Tape or washable chalk is acceptable for marking the jumps, and tennis balls or washable chalk should be used for relays. Please supply your own batons. Northwood will supply starting blocks.
- Zones:** We are asking that coaches help judge exchange zones during the relays. Positions will be assigned on meet day. Flags will be provided
- Implements:** Please weigh in your implements in the bottom of the press box.
- Sprints:** In the short sprints, the heats will be seeded as evenly as possible based on submitted times, while keeping athletes from the same school in different heats. The top two places from each heat plus the next four fastest times will advance. In the 200 M Hurdles and 400 M Dash, athletes will be placed into two heats, run from slower to faster, based on submitted times. However, anyone can score from either heat.
- Stuff:** We will have our concession stand open, with t-shirts available.
- Awards:** There will be a team trophy for champion. Individually, we will score 6 places, with the top 3 receiving All-Conference ribbons. Awards will be available in the press box after the meet.
- Coaches:** There will be a short coaches' meeting at 4:00 in the press box. There will also be a hospitality room with snacks and drinks for all the coaches there as well.
