**DATE/TIME/LOCATION OF EVENT** - The Bison Kickoff Wrestling Classic/Ron Madow Memorial Wrestling Tournament will be held on **Saturday, December 4, 2021** at Beachwood High School (South Gym); 25100 Fairmount Blvd, Beachwood OH 44122. Wrestling will commence at **10AM**. Please enter through the doors to the South Gym.

**TEAM REGISTRATION** - You must register your team no later than Thursday, December 2 by 7:00pm. You must register your team online by visiting [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com). You can add extras when registering your team. We will let you know if your extras get into the tournament on Friday morning. If your registration is not entered by this date and time, your team may be precluded from registering. You can begin entering your rosters as early as Sunday, November 28 at 8:00 AM.

- **9:00 AM - Doors Open for Spectators**
- **10:00 AM - Wrestling Commences on 3 (or 4) Mats**

#### **COMPETITION FORMAT**

Competing Teams: Beachwood, Bedford, Black River, Brookside, Eastlake North, Padua, Rocky River, and Tallmadge

Six or less entrants = round-robin; seven or eight entrants = two pools, round-robin then two crossover matches (1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup>)

Extras will be included from those registered to boost weight classes that have less than six and/or get them to six, or to get a weight class to eight.

The event will be conducted on three or four mats depending on the number of entrants, with the aim to have each of the five rounds last an hour or just over an hour each.

#### **AWARDS (Awards will be presented at the conclusion of the tournament)**

- Top Two Winner in each weight class (most wins) will receive a medal
- Top two teams will receive a team plaque
- Wrestler with the fastest pin will receive a plaque
- Wrestler with the most pins in the least amount of time will receive a plaque

- Outstanding wrestler will receive a trophy

**Ron Madow Tribute:** There will then be a tribute to Mr. Ron Madow and his family. It may happen prior to the final round, between the third and fourth round, or before the start of the tournament depending on the number of entrants and projected structure of the competition.
