Wrestling Starts: 10 am

Seeding Criteria: We will only seed wrestlers with a **winning varsity record**

1. State Placer
2. District Placer
3. Sectional **Champion**
4. Winning Percentage (10 match min, above 500)
5. Seeded wrestlers must accept the seed and may not be moved to another weight.
6. Weight classes will not be redrawn unless a first or second seed is withdrawn from the tournament OR if a bracket becomes uneven.

Format: **Individual Pool Tournament-6 Rounds**

-Pools 16-13 Wrestlers: 4 Pools of 3-4, winner of each pool goes into a championship bracket for 1st-4th, 2nd place in each pool goes into a consolation bracket and wrestles out to the end.

-Pools:12-11 wrestlers: 4 Pools of 3, winner of each pool goes into a championship bracket for 1st-4th, 2nd place in each pool goes into a consolation bracket and wrestles out to the end.

-Pools: 10-9 wrestlers: 2 pools of 5-4, winners of each pool wrestle for 1st place, 2nd place in each pool wrestles for 3rd, 3rd place in each pool wrestles for 5th

-Pools 8-7 wrestlers: 2 Pools of 4: In round five we will wrestle 1A vs 2B and 1B vs 2A and then the winners will face each other in the final round, losers will wrestle for 3rd. 3rd place in each pool wrestles for 5th

-6 wrestlers or less: Round Robin

Scoring

- Tournament Scoring
- 2 Points for a win
- Bonus Points
- 2 pts for Fall
- 1.5 pts for Tech Fall
- 1 pt for Major Decision

Placement Points

- 1: 16
- 2: 12
- 3: 9
- 4: 7
- 5: 5 - no awards given for 5th place
- 6: 3 - no awards given for 6th place

Round Robin Tie Breaker

5/ Tie-Breaker Criterion

The winner shall be the wrestler who:

1. Won the greater number of matches.
2. Won the head-to-head match.
3. Has been penalized the least number of team points for flagrant or unsportsmanlike conduct.
4. Accumulated the greater number of team points for all matches.
5. Accumulated the greater number of team points for all for falls, defaults, forfeits, or disqualifications.
6. Accumulated the greater number of team points for technical falls.
7. Accumulated the greater number of team points for major decisions.
8. Accumulated the greater number of team points for decisions.
9. Accumulated the greater number of pins in the least time.
10. Accumulated the quickest pin.
11. Accumulated the greatest total point differential for decisions.
12. If none of the above resolves the tie, a flip of a coin will be used.

Rosters are due on **Thursday, January 22nd by 10:00 pm**. You will submit your roster, with extras on Baumspage. Please order your extras in the priority that you would like them to get into the tournament. **It is important that you submit your roster on time so we can prepare the pools for Saturday and let coaches know what extras are getting into the tournament. No wrestler will be moved to a different weight class on Saturday morning.**
