Tournament Notes

Admissions – The price of admission will be \$7.00 for everyone – Adults, Students and Senior Citizens. *Free admission will be granted to only those who are documented on the team pass. GLC Passes will be honored for admission.*

Each school must e-mail the pass list to Mark McGuire at Westlake High School on or before Thursday, February 10th. The Pass list is included in this packet.

Hospitality Room – A Hospitality room will be open to workers, coaches and officials ONLY. Bus drivers, parents and wrestlers are welcome to go to the concession stand.

Locker Rooms- Lockers are available to secure the wrestlers valuables. Please remind your wrestlers to bring a lock. Locker Room assignments will be made the morning of the tournament.

Tournament Seeding Information

(as stated in the GLC Constitution/By-Laws)

Conference Meet Procedures

- A. Coaches will enter their seed nominations/lineups online by date specified by the tournament manager (typically 2 days prior to tournament). The tournament manager will pre-seed the tournament using the online seed nominations. Once the lineup is entered online, the weight class cannot be changed for a wrestler.
- B. A seed review/scratch meeting will take place after weigh-ins during the coaches meeting. A substitute wrestler may be entered in place of a wrestler who sustains an injury, becomes ill, or fails to make weight.
- C. Four wrestlers will be seeded in each weight class

Seeding Criteria:

- A. Wrestlers will be seeded according to the following criteria in order:**
 - a. **Returning state placer at the same weight (in order of placement)**
 - b. **Returning state placer at a different weight (in order of placement)**
 - c. **Returning state qualifier at the same weight (in order of District placement)**
 - d. **Returning state qualifier at a different weight (in order of District placement)**
 - e. **Returning District 5th and 6th place (in order of placement)**
 - f. **Returning conference champion, GLC or SWC, at the same weight***
 - g. **Returning conference champion, GLC or SWC, at a different weight***
 - h. **Returning conference runner-up, GLC or SWC, at the same weight***
 - i. **Returning conference runner-up, GLC or SWC, at different weight***
 - j. ***if two or more - head-to-head match during the season will break the tie.**
 - k. ***if they did not wrestle during the season item I. will break the tie.**
 - l. **Overall Conference record**
- B. To be seeded, all remaining participants must wrestle in at least 6 (six) conference matches and have at least a .500 record in any weight class. Seeding will be based on GLC competition at all weight classes.**
- C. Anyone that is eligible for seeding must be seeded.**
- D. Byes will be placed in the bracket by the tournament director, meet manager and head coaches agreement during the coaches meeting. All efforts will be made to ensure the fairness of bye placement.
- E. In case two (2) wrestlers have identical winning percentages, the following criteria will be applied in the order listed:
 - a. If the participants wrestled each other during the season in a conference match, the winner will receive the higher seed.
 - b. The wrestler with the most conference matches will be seeded higher. Ties in the record are eliminated when considering percentages but count toward the total number of matches wrestled.
 - c. If a tie remains, then a coin flip will be used to determine the seeded position.
- F. In case three (3) or more wrestlers have identical percentages, use the criteria in the order listed above until only two (2) participants remain with identical percentages. Then use the criteria for two (2) identical percentages. (Sect E.)

Conference Team Championship

The Conference Championship will be determined by the Conference Dual Meet Standings (50%) and the Conference Tournament (50%)

Points awarded according to the order of finish for both dual meet records and conference tournament finish will be:

1st - 12 points, 2nd - 11pts, 3rd - 10pts, 4th - 9pts, 5th - 8pts, 6th - 7pts,
7th - 6pts, 8th - 5pts, 9th - 4pts, 10th - 3pts, 11th - 2pts, 12th - 1pt

Please be sure to include your current league dual meet record on the pass list.

Individual All-Conference Selections

- A. The 1st Place Finishers in the Conference Meet will be named 1st Team All-Conference.
- B. The 2nd Place Finishers in the Conference Meet will be named 2nd Team All-Conference.
- C. 3rd place finishers will receive Honorable Mention status
- D. Most Valuable Wrestler will be voted on by the head coaches or their representatives.
- E. The conference statistics are the only statistics that can be used for most valuable wrestler honors
- F. All ballots will be read aloud.
- G. The head coach may vote for his/her own wrestler.
- H. Any tie will be re-voted. If a tie occurs the second time, both nominees will receive the recognition.
- I. The Most Valuable Wrestler is considered a first team member.
- J. Coach of the Year will be awarded to the coach of the Conference champions.

Podium awards ceremony will occur following the next match.

The coach of the champion wrestler will present the awards to the weight class...so please be prepared to do so.

Medals have been generously donated to present to the top 4 placing wrestlers.
