HS Wrestling will Start approx. 12:00pm

WEIGHT-INS: High School: 10:00am-11:00am  
Middle School: Home School Weight Ins (Bring Weigh In Sheet)  
Weigh-ins will be by team.  
Coaches, please report to the head table upon arrival to turn in your alpha sheets and make any scratches. Please drop off your wrestlers at the front entrance of the High School. Ask your bus drivers to park in front of the High School in the main parking lot.

TEAM ENTRY: **Please submit your line up on or before 5:00pm FRIDAY: December 27, 2024 on [Baumspage.com](http://Baumspage.com).** This gives us an estimate of how we can best run the tournament.

We will take up to 20 wrestlers per weight class. **Extra Wrestlers ARE ENCOURAGED BUT NOT GUARANTEED.** We may bump kids around to fill weight classes. We want to continue to grow girls wrestling so we encourage you to enter your extras wrestlers.

The entry window will remain open until Sunday, December 29 at 7:00am. This will allow coaches to modify their rosters up until the day of competition.  
**THIS WILL BE YOUR OFFICIAL ENTRY FOR YOUR WRESTLERS.**

FORMAT: The Lady Rams Rumble is a round robin style tournament with the goal of getting wrestlers as many matches as possible. This format will include the following:

1. Weight classes will be wrestled in either a round robin format or a pool/bracket format.
2. Weight classes with an odd number of wrestlers will be evened out with an "Extra" wrestler.
  - a. All "Extra" wrestlers used will wrestle and score points for the "Extra Team". Team points can be lost and deducted from the "Extra Team" total. Any points deducted from a coach while coaching an "Extra" wrestler will be deducted from that coach's varsity team points.
3. We will run up to 7 rounds plus the finals.
  - a. All matches in a Round Robin Pool will be (3) three 2-minute periods until the finals (MS- (3) 1:30-minute periods).
  - b. Third and Fifth place matches will be 1-2-2 (MS- 1-1:30, 1:30).
  - c. If a wrestler is in a consolation BRACKET, these will also be 1-2-2 periods.
4. Placement:
  - a. HS: Top (6) will Medal.
  - b. MS: Top (4) will Medal.
5. Team points will be determined by dual meet scoring criteria.
  - a. There will **NOT** be any advancement points.
  - b. Byes will be scored after a win in the pool.
    - i. HS: Placement points will be based on 6 placements.

- ii. MS: Placement points will be based on 4 placements.

FINAL ROUNDS: Consolation final matches (3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup>) will be wrestled as soon as possible after the final preliminary match is complete after allowing all wrestlers to achieve the required 30-minute break.  
The Championship Final Round will begin Immediately after the consolation final round. MS awards will be awarded in the Gymnasium Foyer after the MS tournament is complete.  
HS awards will be awarded after weight classes 120, 145, and 235 on the center mat. This will allow parents to take pictures of the MS wrestlers while we continue the HS tournament. It will also allow HS parents to take pictures from the stands and allow us to continue placement order of round robins.

**\*\*\* The High School Championship Matches will take place under spotlights. \*\*\***

Our Area has not been able to keep up with the rapid growth of girls wrestling that bigger areas have. My goal, like many of yours, is to help grow wrestling! Growing girls wrestling in our area is vital to keep up with the competition statewide. Making the finals a big deal with spotlights, intro music, walk out tunnel and smoke cannon may help spark interest in our area and grow girls wrestling! It is a great environment for these young ladies!

TEAM AREA: The cafeteria will be utilized as the TEAMS AREA, please keep all bags, coolers and other team items in the cafeteria.

SPECTATORS: All spectators should enter the building through the front of the High School. There will be room available in the cafeteria for team food and team items. There will be no electrical service. Please leave the area as you found it.

No smoking is allowed on the school grounds.

SPORTS MED: Our Team trainer will be at the tournament all day. The Madison EMS will be notified and on call.
