COACHES' INFORMATION SHEET

A coaches meeting will be held immediately following the weigh-ins, Weigh-in on Saturday start at 7:30 am-9:00 am, start time will be at 10:00 am. Please do not arrive before 7:00 a.m. More importantly, do not be late for weigh-ins. **We will be conducting weigh-ins by teams, so it is important that all teams are on-time.** If you are going to be late for any reason, contact AD/Tournament Director, George Gamble at 216-338-5370 (cell) as early as possible.

We will have the concessions stand open during the entire tournament; it will be open until the start of Championship Round

Those not officially entered will be required to pay admission to the tournament. Also coaches must bring the **Alpha Weigh-In sheets** and present them at weigh-in.

Each team will be assigned locker rooms. **You are responsible for the condition of your locker room.** It is imperative that you, coaches, keep track of your kids and their belongings.

***Please make sure showers are turned off after use.**

***If you want to leave items in the locker room bring a lock to secure them.**

***All valuables should be left at home. Marion-Franklin nor Columbus City Schools are not responsible for any lost/stolen items.**

***Only wrestlers and coaches should be in the locker area! No Exceptions.**

We will honor the **TOP TWO TEAMS** and **1st-4th place** in each weight class at the conclusion of the Tournament. Any protest should be lodged directly to **GEORGE GAMBLE AD/Tournament Director**. All referee decisions are final.

WEIGH-IN PROCEDURE

Saturday 7:30 a.m.

- 2 scales
- All wrestlers and coaches report to the gym*
- Coaches must be with the team, have **ALPHA REPORT** *
- Refs/weigh-in officials at scales

WEIGH-IN by Team

- Referees will conduct skin and nails check for each individual before they approach the scale. Athletic Trainer will be on hand to assist in skin inspection. Referees have final say in all skin issues.
- Two scale workers will conduct weigh-ins on the scale. Assistance from coaches in this process is needed and appreciated.

* **Note** – Coaches **MUST PRESENT** OHSAA Wrestling Weight Certification **ALPHA MASTER REPORT** before weigh-in to AD/Tournament Director, George Gamble, or Head Wrestling Coach, Floyd Cisco.
