- **Format is based upon number of wrestlers in each weight class.**
 - Double Elimination, 1st through 6th places will be awarded
 - 3 Mats will be used through the 3/4 matches.
 - Finalists will be introduced and will meet in designated area.
 - Wrestlers will receive their awards following the Finals.

Awards: MVL Patch for Champions, Medals Places 1-6, Most Valuable Wrestler for upper and lower weight class.

Accommodations:

MVL Tournament Seeding

(Based on twelve team tournament)

1. rat-tail (if needed) placed before seeding (coming into line #2 and 3, 6 and 7).
2. byes placed before seeding (line #3; then if needed, line #6; then if needed, line #7; then if needed, line #2).
3. #1 seed has choice of line - upper or lower half of bracket.
4. #2 seed has choice of line in opposite half bracket of #1 seed.
5. #3 seed has choice of line in either empty quarter bracket.
6. #4 seed has choice of line in empty quarter bracket.
7. #5 seed choice of line in quarter with 3 or 4 seed
8. #6 seed choice of line opposite quarter of 5 seed
9. Coaches may challenge a seed based on head-to-head results in the current year.
10. All wrestlers who do not meet criteria for seeds will be randomly drawn into the bracket. Any winning percentage will pick lines, the rest will draw

Criteria to earn a seed:

- A. State Placement (1-8) in OHSAA tournament last year.
- B. District Placement (1-6) in OHSAA Tournament last year.
- C. Returning MVL Champion in from last year.
- D. Current Overall Record (10-match minimum and .500 or above)

Weather Cancellation for the MVL Tournament

The home team principal and AD should contact the visiting team principals immediately when the weather is such that completing the meet may be impossible and make a mutual decision as to whether to proceed by 12:00 noon that day.
