Enter through the athletic side (Door N - Near the stadium)

Check in: 6:50-7:50 AM

Coaches report to the back hallway for check-in procedures.

Upon sign in you will receive a tournament packet with the following items.

- Brackets and team information. (check/correct all information)
- 1 pass per qualifier/alternate (NO extra passes for stats, trainer, etc.)
- Each team will receive wristbands (coaches, stats, trainer, bus driver). Team personnel wristbands will be given as follows:
 - 1 qualifier (2 wristbands)
 - 2 to 4 qualifiers (3 wristbands)
 - 5 to 8 qualifiers (4 wristbands)
 - 9 to 14 qualifiers (5 wristbands)

Team personnel wristband and stamp needed for admittance, bullpen entrance, and floor access. Wristbands and stamps will allow admittance to tournament so do not remove. There will be no replacements.

Weigh-in: 8 AM

Please have qualifier passes for wrestlers at weigh-in for an admission stamp. All wrestlers shall be present and remain in the designated weigh-in area (wrestlers will be stationed by weight class in the weigh-in area). Alternates who are available can weigh in after the entered wrestlers as a provision for any wrestlers who are scratched. Alternates will be entered

according to their sectional. If the appropriate alternate is not available, any other alternates will be entered via random draw. All wrestlers should be ready to weigh in at 8 AM

- All OHSAA Skin Authorizations appropriately signed and dated must be presented at weigh in.
- The weigh-in shall proceed through weight classes beginning at 100 lbs. and end immediately upon completion of the 235 lb. class. A contestant may step on and off the first scale two times. If he fails to make weight on the first scale, he shall immediately step on alternate scale one time.

Coaches' Meeting: 9 AM

Please have at least one coach present for final changes and updates.

- *Semifinals & Consolation Quarters (split rd.):* (56 matches – 4 mats)
Championship semifinals on mats 1 & 2 Consolation matches on mat 3 & 4
- *Consolation Semifinals:* (28 matches – 3 mats)
Finalists to the hallway for parade line up.
- *Finals:* (42 matches – 3 mats)
All finalists will be introduced before their match.

After state qualifiers have wrestled, please report to the head table to fill out media forms, state paperwork, and receive a state information packet.

Logistics

Team Meal: All team meals will take place in the commons.

Locker rooms, Bags, Coolers: Locker rooms will be assigned by pre-regional sites. Please limit wrestler's bags in the gymnasium. Wrestlers should leave bags in the locker room or warm up area only. No coolers in the gymnasium.
