Frequently Asked Questions

1. What will the weight allowance be for the state duals circuit?

All weight classes will be Scratch +4 which is consistent with past years through the OHSAA.

2. What is the schedule of events for the day?

10:00 AM Round I: Quarterfinals (4 total matches on 4 mats)

11:30 AM Round II: Championship Semifinals (Winners of Quarterfinal matches)

Consolation Semifinals (Losers of Quarterfinal matches)

1:00 PM Round III: Placement matches (4 matches on 4 mats)

Championship on Mat 1

3rd Place Match on Mat 2 (Losers of Championship Semifinals) 5th Place Match on Mat 3 (Winners of Consolation Semifinals) 7th Place Match on Mat 4 (Losers of Consolation Semifinals)

3. When do the windows open and close for submitting biographical information and voting for seeding?

Participating schools (coaches and athletic directors) will be contacted by Baumspage after they qualify. The window to edit the bio will open Sunday at 12:00 Noon and close on Monday at 12:00 noon. The voting window will open on Monday at 12:00 Noon and close at 12:00 Noon on Tuesday. Please look for the email giving you specific instructions on how to submit tentative roster and team bios for seeding.

4. When and where will brackets be posted?

Brackets will be posted on <u>baumspage</u> by 2:00 PM on Tuesday, February 6, 2024. See links above.

5. How many matches are each team guaranteed?

All teams are guaranteed 3 matches using an 8-Man Modified Consolation Bracket. (See <u>Sample Bracket</u>) Teams winning in the semifinals will wrestle for the championship, and teams losing in the semifinals will wrestle for 3rd place. First-round losers will wrestle in a consolation bracket with winning teams competing for 5th and losing teams competing for 7th place.

6. What awards will be given?

Trophies will be awarded to the Championship and Runner-up teams and plaques for 3rd and 4th place teams.

7. How can I get tickets for the event?

All teams will have ticketing information sent to the head coach and athletic director from the host school. The cost will be \$15 for the all-day event.
