



## 2023 OHSWCA STATE DUALS PRESS RELEASE

The 2023 Ohio Wrestling Coaches Association is again hosting 4 divisions for the 2022-23 wrestling season. The boys will compete in 3 divisions and the girls will again compete in 1 division.

### FORMAT FOR BOYS DISTRICT AND STATE DUALS:

The location of the district tournaments will be decided in early January using the same format as the state duals seeding (Submit team bios and rank all teams except for your own on Baumspage). The other factor will be those schools that have expressed interest in hosting the event by completing the survey.

*Each District host site will have three rounds following the following format (2 mats needed):*

Round #1:	Match One:	Seed #7 vs. Seed #10
Round #2:	Match Two:	Winner of Match One (#7/#10) vs. Seed #2
	Match Three:	Seed #3 vs. Seed #6
Round #3:	Match Four:	Winners of Match Two vs. Match Three
	Match Five:	Loser Match One vs. Loser Match Four

The district tournaments will be held on **Saturday, February 4, 2023**. The make-up date will be **Wednesday, February 8, 2023**.

The state championships will wrestle out to 8th place on **Saturday, February 11, 2023**.
