## 2019 OHSAA DUAL TEAM WRESTLING REGIONAL TOURNAMENT

### Tournament Timeline:

#### Event Timeline:

**Team Check-in:** The Genoa High School and Middle School facilities will open at approximately 7:30 AM for teams to check in and receive their locker room assignments prior to check in. The TEAM entrance and check in area are identified on the Genoa Campus Map.

8:00 AM – Weigh-ins will begin. Designated weigh-in area is identified on the High School Gymnasium Map. The weigh-in shall be the scratch weight plus four pounds. This is the maximum weight allowed by rule. Entire teams will be weighed-in by weight class order. Teams will be assigned weigh-in numbers based on the number of their match. Coaches are permitted to observe the weigh-in.

9:00 AM – 1<sup>st</sup> Round and 2<sup>nd</sup> Round matches on all 4 mats.

- Matches will run sequentially on the next available mat in accordance with the match number designated on the bracket through the completion of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round (Round of 16).
- Teams not beginning at 9:00 AM will be permitted a 10-minute warm-up period prior to the start of their 2<sup>nd</sup> Round match.

**Quarterfinals:** All four quarterfinals will begin immediately after the conclusion of the final match in the second round.

**Semifinals:** Both semifinals will begin immediately after the conclusion of the final match in the quarterfinals.

**Finals:** The finals will begin immediately after the conclusion of the final match in semifinals.

The State Finals will be at 11:00 AM, Sunday, February 10, 2019 at St. John Arena on the campus of The Ohio State University. See [www.ohsaa.org](http://www.ohsaa.org) for times.

**Entry Forms:** Each school shall submit rosters online at [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com) before 12:00 PM (Noon) on Wednesday, January 30. The minimum weight as listed on the Alpha Master Roster and the wrestler weigh-in sheet, must be provided to the tournament manager prior to starting the Regional Tournament.

- The deadline to update team rosters on [www.baumspage.com](http://www.baumspage.com) for the regional round is Wednesday, January 30 at 12:00 PM (Noon).

**Coaches Meeting:** There will be a brief general coaches meeting held in the Middle School Library at 8:40 AM.

**Admission:** The price for admission to the Regional Tournament is \$8 for every spectator, including senior citizens.

**Concessions:** The Genoa Athletic Boosters will be providing food and drink during the tournament. There will be no coolers containing any food or drinks allowed into the school. If you are found with any coolers you will be asked to leave the facility. Roasters, crockpots or team camp meals are also not permitted.

**Inclement Weather:** In the event that wrestling cannot take place on Saturday due to weather, we will wrestle the Regional Tournament on Sunday with the same time table as Saturday. If your school policy prohibits your students from competing on Sunday, please email that information immediately to [djhartsel@genoaschools.com](mailto:djhartsel@genoaschools.com), as that will have an affect on the inclement weather plan.
